

>> Grescasa has introduced a new range of tiles called 'Ecowood' which enthralls visitors with its sheer beauty. The inspiration for Ecowood comes from the solid wooden planks removed from old buildings. Sculpted and emphasised by the action of time, the natural grain is evident in its longitudinal format. Ecowood is reclaimed timber in porcellanato, an environmentally responsible wood. The natural raw materials used in manufacturing the parcellanato are extracted from areas that are immediately recovered.

As well as saving trees, Ecowood can be used in commercial spaces or areas that are subject to humidity, such as kitchens and bathrooms and has the added advantage of being fire resistant.

Ecowood has technical characteristics far superior to wood for use in coverings. Some of its advantages include that it is fire resistant, suitable for use in humid areas, ideal for commercial spaces and is easy to clean. It also makes use of the double press technology which makes it suitable for reproducing natural relief finish.

Grescasa has also introduced a variety of other ranges such as Borneo Jet, Madeira jet, Estonia, Yale and Ebano Jet.
